Start of 2023-2024

Welcome to the first Life Science & Technology newsletter of 2023/2024!

In September, we started with our new cohort of 67 LST students. This is comparable to the amount of first year students we welcomed last year and we are happy with these stable numbers.

We hope you will all be able to find your way around campus with the help of your mentors, and have a good first semester.

Update on previous cohorts

We currently have 37 LST students who have started their second year, and 34 students who have started their third year.

In October, we will have the first diploma ceremony for LST students who started in the new curriculum.

This cohort started in September 2020 under difficult circumstances, with both a COVID-19 lockdown and a whole new curriculum being rolled out. 11 students of that first cohort have managed to graduate within three years, and we wish them luck in their future studies. We hope LST has prepared them well!

Not all these 11 students have remained at the University of Groningen, and the ones who have started their master programme here show the different options you have with LST. There are LST students continuing in Biology, Biomolecular Sciences, Medical Pharmaceutical Sciences, Physics, and even Nanoscience.

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Mentorate

The <u>Programme Committee</u> for LST has kept a close eye on the courses and the curriculum as a whole, and on the information available for students.

If you are curious how courses were evaluated last year, you can see <u>a brief summary</u> available on the Student Portal. Note that not all courses have a summary available yet. If a course ran in period 2B, the PC has not yet had a chance to look at the course evaluation.

First year courses get evaluated every year, while second year courses usually get evaluated every three years, unless there is a big change such as a change in course coordinator. The PC is always open to feedback from staff and students outside of the course evaluations.
