In this unique, internationally oriented Master's programme you will develop the expertise to enable you to select, develop, and nurture talent and creativity in individuals and organisations across achievement domains. You will learn about the theoretical approaches to talent development and creativity, but you will also be in close contact with different organisations in the worlds of sport, arts, industry and education so you can learn to put your knowledge and skills in practice.

As part of your MSc thesis you will carry out a research project, and you will do an internship in the achievement domain that interests you. Many institutes in the world of sports, the army, education, arts, and the industry are connected to our program and offer interesting internship opportunities.

- You will be equipped you with the necessary scientific attitude, insight, and skills to be successful as a researcher or practitioner in the fields of sports, education, arts, work, or music
