

Annex to the Teaching and Examination Regulations Bachelor's degree programme International and European Law

Article 1 – Provisional admission

- 1. At the request of a candidate who wants enter the bachelor's degree programme International and European Law with a HBO-propaedeuse as arranged for in article 2.2 of the LLB Teaching and Examination Regulations, the Admissions Board can decide to provisionally admit a student to the programme, provided:
 - s/he still has to complete a joint maximum course load of 15 ECTS of that HBO-propaedeuse programme.
 - s/he can successfully complete the HBO-propaedeuse before the first of September 2021.
- 2. The provisional admission will be repealed by 31 August 2021 in case the HBO-propaedeuse programme has not been completed on that date.
- 3. The provisional admission as arranged for in Art. 1.1 is only possible in the academic year 2020-2021. The regular entry moments and other entry regulations, such as matching, apply.

Article 2 – Certified copies

To gain admission as arranged for in Article 1, students must provide formal proof of their deficiency through certified copies of their University of Applied Science.
