

## **Transition Regulation possibility ‘do not correct’ master’s degree programmes Faculty of Law 2024/2025**

The possibility of marking an examination with ‘do not correct’ will be terminated for all Faculty of Law degree programmes as of 1 September 2024. For examinations in the master’s degree programmes of the Faculty of Law, it will still be possible to make use of this option until 1 September 2025. The following applies to these programmes:

If a student at a written examination clearly writes ‘do not correct’ on the examination sheet, the student is supposed for this student to not have participated in this examination. No results will be registered for this student in the system. All rights linked to examination participation will then become null and void for this student for such examinations, including among others the right to an aberrant examination regulation as provided for in Article 4.9 of the Teaching and Examination Regulations of the English-taught master programmes.
