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

Bernoulli Institute for Mathematics, Computer Science and Artificial Intelligence	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Prof. Paris Avgeriou (Bernoulli Institute) has acquired a EUR 4.5 million grant within the ITEA program, entitled Managing Sustainability Tradeoffs (MAST). This project will deal with the complex engineering trade-offs involved in optimizing both environmental and technical sustainability and will apply its results in cyber-physical systems and (green) cloud computing.</li></ul>
Centre for Learning and Teaching (CLT)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Dr. Betzabe Torres Olave has been awarded a Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions Postdoctoral Fellowship, with a perfect score of 100% (!), for the project with title Pedagogies for the Imagination: Science Education for Climate Just Futures. Dr. Torres Olave will work with prof. Lucy Avraamidou at the Centre for Learning and Teaching.</li></ul>

Engineering and Technology Institute Groningen (ENTEG)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Dr. Elisabeth Wilhelm is a key partner in a consortium developing a revolutionary type 2 diabetes app. Thanks to the EFRO grant, the consortium around Diavantis can develop the app that will combine AI and IoT technology to analyze real-time health data and provide personalized guidance on topics such as nutrition, exercise, stress, and sleep.</li> </ul>
Groningen Institute for Evolutionary Life Sciences (GELIFES)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Professor of Global Flyway Ecology Theunis Piersma has been appointed a Knight in the National Order of Mauritania. He was awarded this distinction in recognition of his dedication to nature conservation in the Banc d'Arguin, a vital ecological region in the West African country.</li> </ul>
Stratingh Institute for Chemistry	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Professor of Homogeneous Catalysis Syuzanna R. Harutyunyan has been awarded an ERC Proof of Concept Grant from the European Research Council to develop innovative chiral ligands for more efficient and sustainable production of chiral molecules, which are vital for effective drugs and chemicals.</li> </ul>

## Opdracht: ZZP Projectmedewerker Implementatie PNN en PostdocNL

**Ben jij een zelfstandige professional met ervaring in projectondersteuning en affiniteit met de academische wereld? Wil jij bijdragen aan het creëren van een sterker platform voor promovendi en postdocs in Nederland? Dan zijn wij op zoek naar jou!**

### Over PNN en PostdocNL

PNN (Promovendi Netwerk Nederland) is de landelijke belangenorganisatie voor promovendi. PNN zet zich in voor betere arbeidsomstandigheden, loopbaanperspectieven en begeleiding voor promovendi in Nederland. PostdocNL vertegenwoordigt postdocs en zet zich in voor hun professionele ontwikkeling, sociale veiligheid, en toekomstperspectieven in de academische en niet-academische wereld.

PNN en PostdocNL werken samen aan belangrijke thema's voor startende onderzoekers zoals diversiteit en inclusie, sociale veiligheid en professionalisering binnen het hoger onderwijs en onderzoek.

### De opdracht

Met financiële steun van het Ministerie van OCW zullen PNN en PostdocNL hun samenwerking versterken en beide organisaties verder professionaliseren. Voor de implementatie van deze subsidie zoeken wij een ZZP-projectmedewerker die een centrale rol zal spelen bij:

- Het leiden van de implementatie van de subsidie
- Het coördineren en organiseren van vergaderingen en evenementen, inclusief het opzetten van een gezamenlijke overlegstructuur.
- Het ondersteunen bij het opzetten van PostdocNL als vereniging, inclusief het aantrekken van lidorganisaties.
- Het ondersteunen bij administratieve taken, zoals het opstellen en uitzetten van opdrachten en het aantrekken van externe adviseurs.
- Het stroomlijnen van interne processen en het verbeteren van communicatie tussen PNN en PostdocNL.

De opdracht loopt van **februari tot september 2025**, met een mogelijke verlenging bij verstrekking van het beoogde tweede deel van de subsidie. Startdatum is zo spoedig mogelijk.

### Wat verwachten we van jou?

- Ervaring met administratieve en projectmatige werkzaamheden.
- Sterke organisatorische vaardigheden en een gestructureerde werkwijze.
- Affiniteit met de academische wereld, bij voorkeur ervaring met promovendi en/of postdocs.
