Engineering and Technology Institute Groningen (ENTEG)	 Dr. Charissa Roossien from ENTEG together with industrial partners and researchers from the UMCG and HTRIC has successfully secured a substantial Just Transition Fund (JTF) subsidy of €1.8 million. This collaborative effort is aimed at developing and valorizing a cutting-edge health tracker for reliable respiratory and metabolic analysis.
Energy and Sustainability Research Institute Groningen (ESRIG)	 <u>Listen to Henry van der Windt</u>, Associate Professor at ESRIG IREES, in the podcast series 'Future for Nature', produced by The Butterfly Foundation.
Groningen Institute for Evolutionary Life Sciences (GELIFES)	 Do you know the In Science UG podcast? In the latest episode, you can listen to Professor Pablo Tittonell on how to Feed the world with agroecology.
Kapteyn Astronomical Institute	A European team of astronomers, including Amina Helmi and Eduardo Balbinot from UG, has discovered the largest stellar black hole of the Milky Way. The black hole is more than 30 times heavier than our sun and it is located in the Aquila Constellation, approximately 2000 light years from Earth. The astronomers made their discovery by chance while preparing the fourth data release of ESA's Gaia mission, which follows the movements of billions of stars in the Milky Way.
Zernike Institute for Advanced Materials (ZIAM)	Prof. Marleen Kamperman (ZIAM) has been awarded with a Gravitation grant of 1.5 million euros by The Ministry of Education, Culture and Science for her materials research in the Green Tissue Engineering research programme. The consortium will study the mechanical properties of plant cells in order to improve the defences of plants. The following institutes: Perpoulli, CLT, CRB, CRID, Stratingh, and VSL.
