News from the Institutes The NWO has awarded an Open Mind grant of €50,000 to Ajay Kottappali and his team for their groundbreaking project aimed at improving the safety and accuracy of intravenous (IV) infusion therapy. In this grant unusual research ideas that contribute to creative and sustainable solutions to societal challenges are sought. Prof. Marc van der Maarel has been awarded a Biotech Booster grant of EUR 200,000 from the Nationaal Groeifonds Program. Van der Maarel's project focuses on scaling up glycogen produced by Galdieria microalgae as a

	sustainable moisturizing ingredient in a variety of cosmetic products such as shampoo and body lotion.
Energy and Sustainability Research Institute Groningen (ESRIG)	 Paolo Pescarmona, Dulce Morales Hernández, Vassilis Kyriakou (ENTEG), and Aravind Purushothaman (ESRIG) will together receive over 1.5 million euros from the National Growth Fund programme GroenvermogenNL. They are going to contribute to the largest R&D project into green hydrogen in the Netherlands to date. The research at FSE will focus on alkaline water electrolysis and solid oxide electrochemical cells.
Kapteyn Astronomical Institute	'Gids voor de Maan': a scientific and cultural exploration Official presentation of the richly illustrated Gids voor de Maan [Guide to the Moon], written by Peter Barthel, Professor of astrophysics at the Kapteyn Institute, and Klaas van Berkel, Professor of history at the UG on Thursday 17 October at 7.30 p.m. A public presentation will take place at the bookstore Riemer in Groningen, where the public will have the chance to meet the authors and have the book signed.
